ITINERARY

DUBLIN- 2 nights, 1st day in Ireland's beautiful capital city, we will have a panoramic city tour and have the rest of the day and night free. 2nd day is a free day to explore this fascinating city on your own, later that evening, Taylors Three Rock Cabaret and a 4 course dinner.

ATHY- 1 night, In the morning, depart Dublin and travel through the picturesque Wicklow Mts. to experience the early 17th century haunted Wicklow Historical Goal (jail), and Dunbrody Famine Ship. Then travel to Kildare to have the rest of the day, free to explore the very essence of this Irish country market town founded in the 12th century rich with history. Our guest will be ending the day with dinner at the hotel.

KILLARNEY-3 nights, day one en route we will visit the Irish National Stud, Japanese Gardens, and Horse Museum, a unique attraction of outstanding natural beauty that is home to some of the most magnificent horses and sumptuous gardens to be found anywhere in the world. Then to Foynes Flying Boat Museum where you will learn how Irish Coffee was born. Day 2 a jaunting car (horse & buggy) tour through the breathe taking natural mountain wonder Gap of Dunloe with a boat tour of the 7 lakes of Killarney. Day 3 a scenic tour of the Dingle Peninsula.

GALWAY: 2 NIGHTS, a guided tour through Galway, visit the Cliffs of Moher and Ailwee Cave. Day 2 Aran Islands visit to Dun Aengus. There is free time every day.

BUNRATTY- 1 night, visit Bunratty Castle and Folk Park which comprises a collection of farmhouses and a 19th century village street, school etc. where traditional lifestyles and crafts are demonstrated. And for our final night we will celebrate with a Medieval Banquet back at the Castle.
